PARAMEDIC ACCREDITATION

- □ **APPLICATION** Complete Paramedic Accreditation Packet (Signed and Dated)
- CALIFORNIA PARAMEDIC LICENSE Copy (front and back) of Current CA Paramedic License
- □ **PROOF OF EMPLOYMENT** Completed "Statement of Affiliation with Service Provider" form documenting employment with an approved Imperial County ALS Provider Agency
- **STATEMENT OF ELIGIBILITY** Signed and dated as required by CA H&SC Section 1798.200
- BLS CARD Copy (front and back) of Healthcare Provider CPR card
- ACLS CARD Copy (front and back) of current Advanced Cardiovascular Life Support card
- □ VALID ID Copy of valid driver's license, identification card, or federal issued passport
- PROTOCOL EXAM / FIELD EVALUATION If you did not complete your paramedic training program in Imperial County, additional accreditation requirements (i.e. Protocol Exam, Field Evaluation, etc.) will be scheduled by Imperial County EMS Agency staff.
- PAYMENT OF FEES (For Initial Accreditation Only) Non-refundable accreditation fee of \$20; Cash, credit & debit cards are accepted. Payment can be completed at (442)265-1444.
- PROCESSING Applications for certification may be submitted via Email to EMS@co.imperial.ca.us.
 Application may also be brought or mailed to the Imperial County Public Health Department located at 935 Broadway Avenue in El Centro.
- **PASSPORT STYLE PHOTO** Photo of applicant in JPEG or physical format to be included on card.
