I. <u>Purpose:</u>

To establish notification guidelines for EMS personnel transporting patient to a receiving hospital.

II. <u>Authority:</u> Health and Safety code, Division 2.5, section 1797. 220. California Administrative Code, Title 13, Section 1105(c).

III. <u>Policy:</u>

- A. EMS personnel will notify receiving hospitals of an inbound patient transport under the following procedures:
 - 1. When Base Hospital contact is not required under Determination of Death Policy.
 - 2. When Communication failure with the base hospital is encountered
 - 3. Information to be included in notification:
 - a. Unit number
 - b. Patient profile age, sex, pertinent history
 - c. Treatment rendered with response to treatment
 - d. Estimated time of arrival to receiving facility
 - e. Pertinent prehospital alerts if patient is a suspected or confirmed:
 - i. STEMI
 - ii. Stroke
 - iii. Trauma or Burn
 - iv. Imminent Labor
- B. Receiving hospitals will not give orders for treatment. Receiving hospitals may request that EMS make Base Hospital contact for further treatment recommendations.
- C. EMS personnel will not accept orders from personnel from hospitals not designated as Imperial County Base Hospitals.
- D. If EMS makes Base Hospital contact for medical direction, the MICN or Base Hospital Physician will relay report to the receiving facility and document on the EMS Run Sheet.
